***PER HOME DUES:** A “home” is defined as **single OR multi-section manufactured homes** built to the HUD Code or any other state code; a **modular home** built to the UBC Code or any other state or local code; a “**commercial unit**” built to either state or local codes and **park models**.

BRANCH FEES: All correspondence is sent to member company certified representatives. Additionally, general correspondence (that which is not certified representative specific) may be sent to additional employees or locations (branches) of the parent company upon approval of the certified representative for an annual fee of \$120 per employee/location (branch).
